

UNIVERSAL SAFETY CODE: ON INNOVATIVE PEDAGOGICAL METHODS IN PRACTICE-ORIENTED EDUCATION OF CHILDREN TO SAFE ACTIVITY

Abstract. A program is described for additional children's education, teaching them to avoid danger situation in principle and prevent its occurring beforehand. The program forms children's positive position to the life value and their safety. The program is proposed as an addition to the presently used forms and methods of school and out-of-school work with children in the direction of increasing their safety and injury prevention. The program originality is a practice-oriented comprehensive methodological approach to the forming children's stable learned safe pattern behavior in addition to the already existing or new obtained their theoretical knowledge. The principal system-forming element in the program structure is children's learning to a simple universal sequence of action (particular algorithm), well-timed performance of which decreases probability in occurrence of danger situation (risk) and injury.
